Outreach Programs 2020



Indigenous Students at UWA

In 2020, nearly 80 Indigenous students enrolled to study their first degree, diploma or the Aboriginal Orientation Course at UWA. Over 60% of these students participated in our Outreach Program during high school. This year the following programs are on offer:

Year 12 Leadership Seminar (20 – 24 April)

The Seminar provides information about UWA courses, workshops such as self-esteem, study skills, support services and time management as well as cultural and recreational activities.

WACE Revision Camp (12 - 17 July)

Provides students studying towards an ATAR for entry to UWA with tuition during the holidays through sponsoring costs to attend revision courses offered by private providers in Perth.

TISC Information Evening (16 September)

For Indigenous students in Year 12 (with their parent/guardian) who are aiming to gain an ATAR score for entry to UWA. Information is provided by staff from SIS & UWA on the application process, scholarships, residential college etc.

Year 10 Indigenous Science, Health and Engineering Camp (13 - 17 July)

Indigenous students in Year 10 have the opportunity to explore areas of science, health and engineering from a hands-on perspective, including major study areas such as sports science, zoology, medicine, dentistry, physics and engineering.

Year 9 Djinanginy (25 November)

To introduce Year 9 students to the university environment with a mix of lecture, laboratory and practicum style activities.

Year 8 Discovery Days (17, 18 & 19 November)

To introduce Year 8 students to the university environment, where they participate in hands on activities during a one-day program in November.

General Excursions to UWA

Schools bring Indigenous students to UWA by appointment for either an individual or a group visit. The program includes an overview of the University, course information, tertiary student speakers, a tour and an activity.

UWA Open Day (2 August)

The School of Indigenous Studies will be located in the main marquee on James Oval from 10am to 4pm to provide information regarding study, student support and entry options to UWA for Indigenous students.

All activities are provided at no cost to the students through sponsorship provided by the School of Indigenous Studies and UWA.
